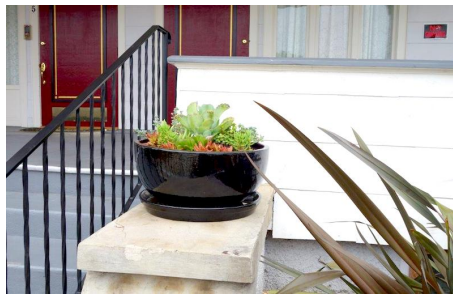
historical place in that community. Vickie was president and then house chairman for 6 years,

responsible for renovations that made the club a popular wedding rental venue on Mission Bay and enabled it to become a 501(c) 3 philanthropic organization. The parallel to Point Loma Assembly is so similar: when the Assembly's membership and building was aging, Vickie and Assembly Superwoman Dottie Laub set to work revitalizing it.

Vickie was the unofficial design consultant for the interior design of the Assembly and is presently working on the fireplace renewal, using a lot of her time and gas running all over the county.

Her husband, Dick, designed the walkway ramp in 2012 and guided the contractors and other workmen through the process.

Her lengthy community involvement includes The Thursday Club, serving as president in 2006-7, and various other board positions for over 20 years. She was a board member of the Point Loma Association and annual dinner chairman for 4 years. She chaired the dinner for the 1992 America's Cup Ball and handled decorations for the Charity Ball. She has been involved with the American Cancer Society,

Membership Report

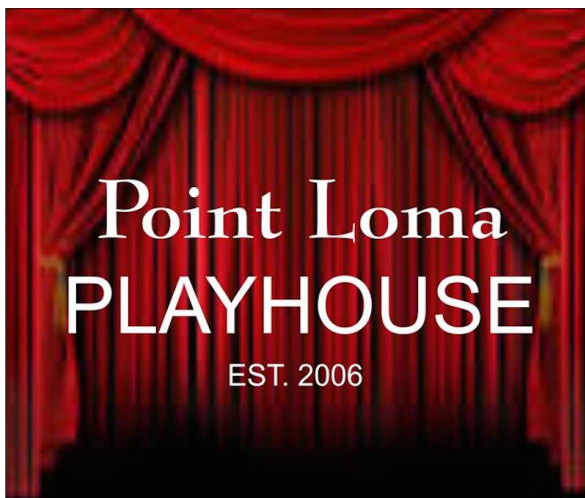
