Marriage, for Better or Worse

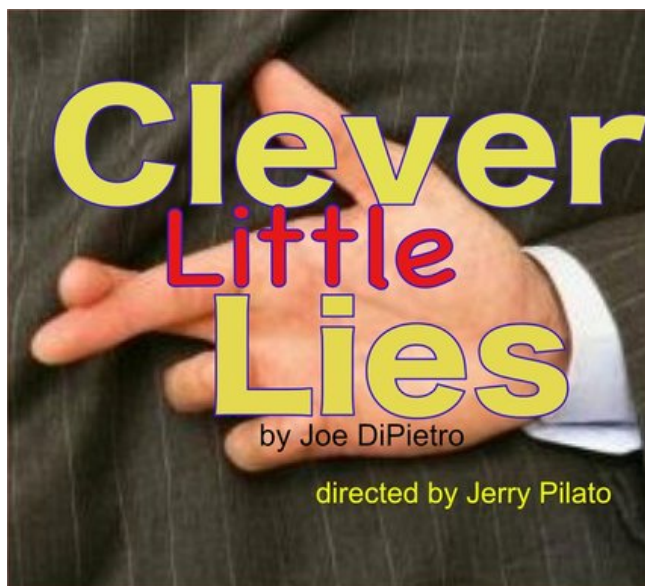
