



Frank and Fred Jennings Early Developers of Roseville

The 1886 Jennings Family Home was the first Registered Historic House site in Point Loma. In addition to building Point Loma's first ferryboat, -*MAV Roseville* the Jennings family, in 1890-1, built the Nail Mill Factory which later housed Roseville's first church, first assembly hall, and first school until 1906 when the Roseville School opened 3 blocks north on Byron Street. In 1911 the family donated the land for the Point Loma Assembly building. Sheriff Fred's daughter Belle Benchley, (*nee* Jennings), was the Director of the San Diego Zoo from 1927 - 1953 and is credited with making the San Diego Zoo one of, -if not *the*, world's finest zoological parks.
